CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clyde B. Stark has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Frenchman Station Well) through well and troughs for stock and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 3, T. 16 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 3, bears S. 74° 51' W., 1,211 feet. situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.006 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 200 cattle
Period of use, from October 1st to March 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 5, 1946

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is developed by a well 250 feet deep cased with 6" casing and equipped with an electric pump. Water is conveyed by 1200 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to troughs located in SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 3, T. 16 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
