CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clyde B. Stark has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (North Well) through well and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T. 17 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 18, bears N. 39° 18' W., 3,750 feet. situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Clyde B. Stark
Post-office address Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0125 or sufficient to water 400 cattle.
Period of use, from October 1st to March 31st following year of 1937
Date of priority of appropriation January 4, 1946

Description of place and manner of use: Water is developed by a well 363 feet deep cased with 6" casing and equipped with a windmill and troughs. The place of use is in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T. 17 N., R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
