CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. S. Proctor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

underground

through well, pump, tank and pipeline for

quasi-municipal & domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 6, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.E.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 Corner of said Section 6, bears N. 16° 00' W., 2,409 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator A. S. Proctor and Jack Thomas

Post-office address P. O. Box 431, Las Vegas, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.02 c.f.s. not to exceed 1.0 m.g. per annum.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 11, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 160 feet deep cased with 8 inch casing and equipped with a 3 HP pump; thence conveyed through a distribution system consisting of 400 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipeline to two dwellings, lawns, trees and shrubs. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
