

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George W. Frisby has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

underground

through well, pump, pressure tank & pipeline for

quasi-municipal and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W $\frac{1}{2}$  corner of said Section 16, bears N. 85° 06' W., 1,098 feet.

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator George W. Frisby

Post-office address P. O. Box 2105, Las Vegas, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s. not to exceed 7 m.g. per annum.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 23, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 237 feet deep cased with 58 feet of 12 inch and 237 feet of 10 inch casing and equipped with a deep well turbine pump; thence conveyed through a pipeline to an 8,000 gallon pressure tank; thence conveyed to the motel units through a system of pipelines. The place of use is within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.


