CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert M. Metten has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and pipelines for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 33, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 33, bears S. 36° 59' 30" W., 747 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.20 c.f.s. not to exceed 14.0 m.g. per annum.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 29, 1952

Description of place and manner of use: Water developed by a well and distributed by pipe lines for use of the Clark County Airport terminal building and facilities in the W 1/2 Section 33, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
