CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jesse Gardner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Deer Spring through ditch and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 25, T. 19 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B.&N., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 25, bears S. 33° 14' E., 2830 feet, situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Jesse Gardner and Bertrand Arambel
Post-office address: White Pine, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0046 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 head of cattle.
Period of use, from: June 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 20, 1952

Description of place and manner of use: Spring is developed by a cut and water is conveyed approximately 23 feet to a concrete trough and there used for watering 150 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
