CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edward L. Pine has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Unnamed Springs through dam, pump and ditches for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T. 19 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of Section 35, T. 20 N., R. 19 E., M.D.M., bears N. 6° 28' 13" W., 2,956.38 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 18, 1954

Description of place and manner of use: 4.0 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T. 19 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
