CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert H. Morrison has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well and pipe lines for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 32, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 32, bears N. 62° 29' E., 2,934.6 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.03 c.f.s. or 8.0 acre feet per annum.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 11, 1944


Description of place and manner of use:
Water is used to irrigate approximately 2.0 acres of land and for domestic use in three homes. Place of use is in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 32, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
