CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. H. Robison has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Meadow Spring

through reservoir for

stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 31, T. 25 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of Section 36, T. 25 N., R. 67 E., bears N. 88° 30' E., 2291 ft. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator B. H. Robison

Post-office address Ely, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0155 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 2500 head of sheep.

Period of use, from October 1st to July 1st following year of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 29, 1951

Description of place and manner of use:

A reservoir is constructed at the spring which is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 31, T. 25 N., R. 68 E., M. D. B. & M., and there used to water 2500 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
