CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, M. T. Magnuson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Tahama Creek (Theama Creek) through ditch and reservoir for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 25, T. 22 N., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 25, bears N. 54° 04' E., 3510 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator M. T. Magnuson
Post-office address McGill, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0325 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 4000 head of sheep and 250 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 7, 1953

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is diverted into a ditch which runs northwesterly through Sections 25, 26 and 27, T. 22 N., R. 64 E., for a distance of approximately 10,650 feet where it empties into a reservoir in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 27, of said township and range. 4000 head of sheep and 250 head of cattle water along the length of the ditch.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
