Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.01875 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 3000 head of sheep.

Period of use, from April 1st to June 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 6, 1950

Description of place and manner of use:

Water is held in ponds and conveyed by channel for use in the NE 1/4 Section 14 and S 1/2 Section 11, T. 14 N., R. 48 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
