CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Karl Bradshaw has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Duckwater Creek through ditches for winter irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 34, T. 12 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 34, bears S. 89° 30' W., 1775 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address: Duckwater, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 3.0 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: November 1st to March 31st following year.
Date of priority of appropriation: April 5, 1951

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
