

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS George Whittell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Marlette Creek and Tributaries through dam, pipeline and power plant for power and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T. 15 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 11, bears S. 49° 48' W., 2102.55 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 15, 1947

Description of place and manner of use: Water is diverted from a reservoir created by means of an earth dam built across Marlette Creek immediately above its junction with North Fork of Marlette Creek. The reservoir is approximately 1,000 feet long and 453 feet long at the dam, which is approximately 25 feet high, with a 4 feet wide by 3 feet high concrete spillway at the southerly end. The water appropriated under this permit is comingled in the reservoir with the water from North Fork of Marlette Creek-Permit No. 12085, and conveyed in a southwesterly direction 1,789 feet by means of a 6 inch pipe to the junction with a 4 inch pipe line which conveys water in a northwesterly direction from South Fork Marlette Creek-Permit No. 12087. The comingled waters from these three creeks covered by Permits Nos. 12085-North Marlette Creek; 12086-Marlette Creek, and 12087-South Fork Marlette Creek are conveyed from the junction by means of a six inch pipe in a northwesterly direction 2,280 feet to the power plant in Lot 4, Section 11, T. 15 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B.&M., where the water is used to generate power by means of a 10 H.P. Pelton wheel situated 200 feet below the intake pipe from the above described reservoir. The water is used for fish pond and domestic. Power generated is used in dwellings, outer buildings, and outside lighting.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
