CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Aaron A. Hansen has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Seepage Waters (Midas Pond) through pump and pipe lines for placer mining purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T. 8 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Section 23, bears N. 21° 25' E., 2400 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 22, 1948

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is pumped from pond and used in a washing plant located in the S 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 23, T. 8 N. R. 43 E., M.D.B.&M. The tailings water is returned to the pond.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
