CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Earl D. Crinite has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, tank, pipeline and Sprinklers for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 20, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 20, bears S. 88° 21' W., 2,033.1 feet, situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.10 c.f.s., not to exceed 15 acre feet per season.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 7, 1945

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
3.00 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
