

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George M. Holstein has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and pipe lines for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 4, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 4, bears N. 81° 31' W., 2260 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s., not to exceed 4.0 m.g. per annum.
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation May 26, 1952

Description of place and manner of use:
Water developed by a drilled well and pumped through pipe lines to two commercial buildings and an eleven-unit motel in a portion of the SW 1/4 Section 4, T. 20 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
