CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Howard B. Cahoon has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and pipe lines for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 7, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 7, bears N. 11° 07' E., 1,000 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Howard B. Cahoon
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.02 c.f.s., not to exceed 0.4 m.g. per annum.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 23, 1952

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is developed by a drilled well and is pumped through pipe lines for use in a drive-in theatre in the E 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 7, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
