

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ebbie H. Davis has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Colorado River through Lake Mohave for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 36, T. 26 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of Section 10, T. 26 S., R. 65 E., M.D.M., bears N. 26° 22' W., 25,718 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Ebbie H. Davis
Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0023 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 75 head of cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 7, 1953

Description of place and manner of use: Cattle water along the shore of the lake in the vicinity of the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
