CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Adrien Kuffer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground through well, pump, tank and pipeline for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 32, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 32, bears S. 24° 32' E., 1,353.6 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Adrien Kuffer
Post-office address: Route 1, Box 23, Moorpark, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s., not to exceed 5.5 m.g. per annum.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 30, 1940

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 410 feet deep cased with 380 feet of six inch casing and equipped with a 1 1/2 H.P. electric pump and a 320 gallon pressure tank; thence conveyed through 400 feet of 2 1/2 inch and 400 feet of 2 inch pipeline to 15 residences. The places of use are within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
