CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ada C. and Vernon P. Young has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Fletcher Spring through pipeline and reservoir for stock and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, T. 19 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 30, bears S. 56° 11' E., 2,900 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ada C. and Vernon P. Young
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.00196 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 60 head of stock.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 13, 1953

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed from spring through approximately 3 miles of 4" pipe to a small reservoir and storage tank located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28, T. 19 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
