CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Earl Edgar has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lehman Creek through dam and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 8, T. 13 N., R. 70 E., M.D.B.&M., as described by decree. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows: Name of appropriator Clarence B. Smith (1/2 interest) Earl and Dolores N. Edgar (1/2 interest). Post-office address Baker, Nevada. Amount of appropriation 0.691 c.f.s., or 319 acre feet per annum. Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year. Date of priority of appropriation January 19, 1918.
