The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 23, T. 15 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¹/₄ corner of said Section 23, bears N. 15° 21' 30" W., 1444.0 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Emma and Harold Schaefer
Post-office address: Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.00625 c.f.s., or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle.
Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 25, 1916

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is diverted into trough and reservoir and used to water 200 head of cattle. Place of use is the same as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
