

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS: Dallas Kingsbury has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, tank and pipeline for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 1, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 1, bears S. 85° 15' W., 3,460 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Dallas Kingsbury
Post-office address: 2851 Fremont Street, Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s., not to exceed 1.4 m.g. per annum.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 10, 1952

Description of place and manner of use: Water is developed by means of a well from which it is pumped through pipe lines to serve 13 trailers and one home located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
