CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Vincen Leavitt has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground through well, storage tanks and pipelines for farmstead and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 35, T. 13 S., R. 70 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which corner No. 4, tract 44 of Section 35, T. 13 S., R. 70 E., bears N. 19° 41' W., 2,228 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 4, 1952

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is developed by means of a well and is stored in concrete and metal storage tanks. Water is conveyed by means of pipe lines to the place of use in the community of Bunkerville within the SW 1/4 and NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 25, T. 13 S., R. 70 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
