CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Edward Garaventa has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground through well, pump and pipe lines for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T. 29 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Section 33, bears N. 87° 30' E., 600 feet. situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Big Meadow Water Association
Post-office address: Lovelock, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 1.0 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 11, 1952

Description of place and manner of use: Water is conveyed by City of Lovelock pipe line to a reservoir; thence by the Association's distribution lines to the place of use in portions of Township 25 North, Range 30 East; Townships 25, 26 and 27 North, Range 31 East, and Township 26 North, Range 32 East, and there used for stockwatering and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
