CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Roy Wilbur has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (A Spring) through pipelines for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 36, T. 6 S., R. 39 E., M. D. B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of Section 33, T. 6 S., R. 39 E., bears S. 85° 05' W., 16,270 feet. situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Roy L. Wilbur
Post-office address: Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.10 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 7, 1952

Description of place and manner of use: Spring developed and water is conveyed through approximately 1800 feet of various size pipe to the place of use in E 1/2 E 1/2 of Section 35; W 1/2 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36; and SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 25, all in T. 6 S., R. 39 E., M.D.B.&M., and there used for placer mining and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
