CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kelly F. Naples has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground through well, pump, pressure tank and pipe/line for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 22, bears N. 33° 28' W., 1,162 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Kelly F. Naples
Post-office address Route 1, Box 119 A, Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s., but not to exceed 35,000 gallons per day.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 2, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 300 feet deep cased with 300 feet of 10 inch casing, and equipped with a Peerless pump driven by a 5 H.P. motor; thence conveyed to a 5000 gallon pressure tank; thence conveyed to 22 houses and 2 lots. The place of use is within the N 1/2 SW 1/4 of Section 22, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
