CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kenneth W. Mansfield has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring through tank and pipelines for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 (Lot 8) Section 14, T. 22 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Section 14, bears S. 78° 46' W., 1865 feet. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Kenneth W. Mansfield
Post-office address: Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.01 c.f.s., not to exceed 1440 g.p.d.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 2, 1953

Description of place and manner of use: Spring is developed and fenced with a collecting tank near the spring from which water is conveyed by pipeline to the place of use located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 (Lot 9) Section 14, T. 22 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
