

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. M. Raycraft has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground through well and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 15, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE 1/4 corner of Section 3, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., bears N. 8° 40' W., 8,765 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 2.00 c.f.s., or 695 acre feet per season.
Period of use, from February 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 11, 1947

* NOTE: Not to exceed a yearly duty of 5 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
