CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Max W. Ercanbrack has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pine Spring through pipeline and cement trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 32, T. 2 S., R. 63 E., M.D.B.&M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the S.W. corner of Section 32, T. 1 S., R. 65 E., bears N. 63° 04' E., 65,850 feet, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Byron A., Lowell M., and Max W. Ercanbrack
Post-office address: P. O. Box 32, Alamo, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0031 c.f.s., or sufficient water for 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from: March 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 18, 1948

Description of manner and place of use: Water is conveyed from the point of diversion through various size pipes to a cement trough located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion and there used for watering 100 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
