CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Pete Etcheverry has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Upper Grub Canyon Spring through reservoir, pipes and trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 30, T. 21 N., R. 48 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/2 corner of said Section 30, bears N. 73° 47' W., 585 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Pete Etcheverry
Post-office address: P. O. Box 1074, Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.014 c.f.s., or sufficient water for 2200 head
Period of use, from: May 15th to October 15th of sheep
Date of priority of appropriation: March 5, 1954

Description of point of diversion, place and manner of use:
Water is developed by a spring and then stored in an open reservoir; thence conveyed through various sizes and lengths of pipe to a watering trough located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion, and there used for watering 2200 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
