

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Roland H. Wiley has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and pipelines for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 23, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Section 23, bears S. 76° 42' W., 430.8 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Roland H. Wiley
 Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada
 Amount of appropriation 0.50 c.f.s., not to exceed 20.0 m.g. per annum.
 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation September 1, 1945

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is developed by a well from which it is pumped through pipelines to serve 184 trailer spaces, 12 motel units and two houses located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
