CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Lucy I. Mead Campbell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and pipelines for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Section 34, bears N. 44° 15' W., 1,045 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lucy I. Mead Campbell
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.10 c.f.s., not to exceed 1.5 m.g. per annum.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 10, 1948

Description of place and manner of use: Water is developed by a drilled well and is pumped through pipelines to 5 houses in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 34, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
