CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank D. Rathbun, Jr., Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, tank, pipeline & sprinklers for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NE 1/4 Section 19, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Section 19, bears N. 87° 34' E., 1,187.6 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s., or 10 acre feet per annum,  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well equipped with a turbine pump; thence conveyed to the place of use by means of pipelines and there used for domestic purposes and the irrigation of two acres of land. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

\* Priority of Permit No. 10858.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
