CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. Russell Lyon has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from McFarland Spring through collecting tanks and pipelines for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 13, T. 18 S., R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of Section 1, T. 18 S., R. 55 E., M.D.M., bears N. 4° 41' E., 14,835.8 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: United States of America, Forest Service
Post-office address: Ogden, Utah
Amount of appropriation: 0.0144 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: May 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 24, 1949

Description of place and manner of use: Spring area is developed by collecting tanks and tile drain from which it is conveyed by pipelines to the places of use located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 13, T. 18 S., R. 55 E., and SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 18, T. 18 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
