CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Murten G. Hiett has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Twin Falls Spring

through pipelines for

domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 36, T. 19 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Section 36, bears N. 54° 30' W., 2,240 feet,

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Nevada National Forest (United States Forest Service)

Post-office address Ogden, Utah

Amount of appropriation 0.013 c.f.s.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 15, 1950

Description of place and manner of use:

Three springs are developed and the water conveyed to a common collecting box whence it is piped to recreational areas in Sections 31 and 32, T. 19 S., R. 57 E., and Section 36, T. 19 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
