CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. C. Bishop, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Goldacres Well No. 2) through well, pump and pipelines for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, T. 28 N., R. 47 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Section 33, bears N. 33° 08' E., 1,480 feet. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: The London Extension Mining Co.
Post-office address: Beowawe, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.666 c.f.s.
Period of use, from: January 1st to: December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 26, 1952

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is developed by a drilled well and is pumped through approximately 2.5 miles of pipe, and there used for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The place of use is in Lots 2, 3, 6, and 7, Section 31, T. 28 N., R. 47 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
