CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, L. E. Tyson, City Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump and pipelines for municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 20 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.W. corner of said Section 24, bears N. 37° 08' W., 2,052.3 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: City of North Las Vegas
Post-office address: North Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.35 c.f.s., not to exceed 10.0 m.g. per annum.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 10, 1947

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is developed by a well from which it is pumped through pipelines for municipal use within the corporate limits of the City of North Las Vegas, Nevada.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
