CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles Culverwell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Old Culverwell Spring


through ditches for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 8, T. 4 S., R. 67 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of said Section 8 bears S. 35° 59' 59" W., 2,669.47 feet, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address: Caliente, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.48 c.f.s. or 240 A.F. per annum
Period of use, from April 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 19, 1941

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
