CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harvey L. Titus has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from South Canyon Spring

through Pipe and troughs for Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 7, T. 9 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.W. corner of T. 10 N., R. 51 E., bears N. 0° 55' W., 5,894.38 feet.

situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Harvey L. Titus and M. E. Locke

Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada

Amount of appropriation .0077 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 22, 1930

Description of place and manner of use:


Rock dam at the spring from which water is piped approximately 50 feet to troughs where it is used to water 250 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
