CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Walter L. Gardner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through Well, pump and pipe lines for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 13, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N. 1/4 corner of said Section 13 bears N. 44° 27' 58" E., 1,872.2 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Walter L. Gardner
Post-office address: Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.08 c.f.s. or 5.0 A.F. per annum
Period of use, from: January 1 to: December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 15, 1952

Description of place and manner of use:
Water is developed by a well from which it is pumped through pipe lines for domestic use and irrigation of 1.0 acre of land located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
