

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, M. K. Hawkins has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground ( Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through well, pump, tank and pipelines for Commercial and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE<sup>1</sup> SE<sup>1</sup>, Section 32, T. 21 S., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Section 32 bears S. 16° 37' 50" E. 1.062.2 feet. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Save-U-More Stations  
Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.01 c.f.s. not to exceed 2,500 gal. per day.  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation March 28, 1955

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, whence it is pumped to a storage tank thence through pipelines to the place of use which is in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.  
Water is used for a service station.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
