CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Frank W. Groves, Director has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Slough (tail and waste water from Lockes Ranch) through Dikes, ditches and ponds for Recreational and Wild Life purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T. 8 N., R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE 1/4 corner of said Section 23 bears West 580 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of -1937- has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 17, 1952

Description of Works of diversion manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from a slough by means of an earthen dike 250 feet long into a ditch 6 feet wide, 2 feet deep and about 1/4 mile long; thence conveyed into a natural drainage channel leading to the pond areas at New Well No. 1. The place of use is within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 & NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 24, T. 8 N., R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
