CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Albert S. Gubler has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from White River Sloughs

through dams and ditches for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 30, T. 11 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 25, T. 11 N., R. 61 E., bears S. 62° 00' W., 7,520 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
