CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bertrand Arambel has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from North Spring (North Willow Spring) through concrete box, pipe and reservoir for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 31, T. 19 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B.&M., whence the S.E. corner of Section 12, T. 18 N., R. 59 E., bears S. 64° 19' 10" E., a distance of 32,311 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bertrand Arambel
Post-office address: Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.005 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 cattle
Period of use, from: June 1st to: November 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 15, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from North Willow Spring by means of a concrete collection box (5'x8'x5'), whence it is conveyed by pipeline to a ditch and reservoir located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
