CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bertrand Arambel has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Spring through pipeline and tank for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE<sup>1</sup> SE<sup>1</sup> Section 10, T. 18 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B.&M., whence the S.E. corner of Section 12, T. 18 N., R. 59 E., bears S. 78° 35' E., 11,152 feet.

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Bertrand Arambel  
Post-office address Eureka, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.005 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 150 cattle  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation December 15, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed from Willow Spring by means of a 2 inch pipeline which conveys the water a distance of 250 feet, whence it is placed in a cement-lined rock tank which is in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
