CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, H. D. Mills has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Old Emigrant Spring

through concrete box, tank and pipeline for Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 14, T. 32 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Section 14 bears N. 65° 56' 25" E., 1,386.97 feet.

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 23, 1956

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed at the spring area by two excavations, then collected and conveyed to storage tanks from which it is conveyed by pipeline to a Maintenance Station and yard, in the NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 14, T. 32 N., R. 50 E., M.D.B.&M., and there used for domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
