WHEREAS, W. Dalton La Rue has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Underground

through well, pump, tank and pipelines for

Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW¹ SE¹ Section 10, T. 22 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E¹ corner of said Section 10 bears N. 58° 30' E., a distance of 2,420 feet.

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46 Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator W. Dalton and Juanita S. La Rue



Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 400 cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 10, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from an underground source by means of a well, whence it is pumped to a storage tank, thence through pipelines where it is used for stockwatering and domestic purposes in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
