CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settlemeyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Well No. 15)

through well, pump, storage tank and pipelines for Municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, T. 34 N., R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S.E. corner of said Section 9 bears S. 85° 36' E., 1,089 feet.

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 1.50 c.f.s.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 6, 1952

Description of works of diversion, manner and place:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well 16 inches in diameter for 375 feet, then 12 inches in diameter for an additional 90 feet. The water is pumped by means of a deep well turbine to a storage tank, thence through pipelines and water mains to the place of use within the limits of the City of Elko.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
