CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. H. Settelmeyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mohawk Springs


through ditches and pipelines for Mining and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 7, T. 45 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Section 7 bears N. 23° 00' 09" E., 1,022.13 feet,  
situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Elko, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s.  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation November 15, 1951

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is developed by means of a spring which has been developed by an open trench 5 feet wide, 35 feet long and 0 to 12 feet deep, whence water is conveyed to the place of use by means of ditches and pipelines. The place of use is in the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 7, T. 45 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
